Kaye retired in the spring of 1975 having spent the bulk of her teaching career in Woodstock. While living in Woodstock she was a very active member of Saint James United Church where she could be found every Sunday in the choir. As a community volunteer she started a senior's exercise class which met regularly at the Legion as well as swim exercise classes both of which became very popular. As a traveller she explored the world exercising her talent as a "poet" recording her journeys in poetry.
